Director's and Technical Services Report

Director Handrina-Wilhelm spoke about the opening of the new Roger and Nancy Orlady Community Room, the upcoming Fox Cities Reads featuring *Remarkably Bright Creatures* by Shelby Van Pelt, and considerations for severe weather.

Adult Services Department

Hess talked about Zaborowske's recent successful presentation on AI to the Neenah Club, the fun of the Library After Dark: Latin Dance Party, and the record year for Book Club to Go with a 24% growth over the last year.

Circulation Services Department

Baird gave a report on the top circulating books for 2025, which were different for each of the 3 major libraries in our area, and shared that we had 24 checkouts of the new Experience Passes in December 2025.

Youth Services Department

Wulff reflected on a successful and inspiring NEWI Youth Services SLP Workshop that brought 32 librarians from around the region to Neenah Public Library, and shared excitement for the upcoming and ever-popular Stuffed Animal Clinic, which is as much fun for our teenaged nursing-student volunteers as it is for the kids.

On the motion of Fieldhack, seconded by Codner, the Board unanimously approved payment of the December bills.

2026 Library Board Officers

The nominating committee consisted of Irish and Koller. Koller presented the slate of officers for 2026: Fieldhack for President, Koller for Vice President, and Rickman for Chair of Finance and Personnel. No further nominations were presented.
