There was a consensus of the Committee to explore if there are areas in the County's Zoning Ordinance that can be removed or amended, as well as looking into developing an ad hoc Committee comprised of representatives of the Towns to discuss this item.

J. Bougie stated that he will follow up with the County Executive's Office with regard to this item.

H. Miller stated that he would prefer not placing this item on their agenda until there is new information to update them on.
