Status update regarding Scott ("Sky") Carpenter.

Mary-Anne Mueller provided updates.

- On June 28th, Circuit Court Judge Theresa Basiliere issued an order for an appropriate residential option for community placement that must be prepared by Winnebago County. Report must be submitted to DHS within 120 days of the order. An appearance has been filed in the case by Mary-Anne Mueller. A Notice of Intent to

Pursue Post-Conviction or Post Disposition Relief has been filed for Scott ("Sky") Carpenter. However, the county is statutorily obligated to provide housing for 980 offenders.

- Mike Elder stated that three tiny homes are built and ready for occupancy. The address that can be used is: 853 West County Road Y.
 - The tiny house is similar to a one-bedroom apartment with laundry facilities.
- Mary Anne Mueller stated that the committee will meet again in approximately four weeks to appoint new officers.
